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The undersigned states as follows:

1. The undersigned is Executor of the above-named estate.
2. Harry P. Jones died testate on November 1, 2000, domiciled in Story County, Iowa.
3. June A. Jones was appointed Executor of the estate by order of this Court dated November 4, 2000, and the undersigned qualified as Executor and is presently acting as such. Notice of such appointment has been duly published, as shown by the affidavit of the publisher filed herein, and more than four months have elapsed since completion of publication of such notice.
4. The probate inventory has been duly filed.
5. The surviving wife of said Decedent is June A. Jones, residing at 5873 Oak Street, Ames, Iowa 50300. The laws pertaining to the determination of said surviving wife's interest in this estate have been complied with.
6. The names, addresses and relationships of the Distributees of the Decedent are as follows:

There were no children born to or adopted by the Decedent after the making of the Last Will and Testament.

All of Decedent's children are also children of the surviving wife.

7. No distributee is under any legal disability. No conservator has been appointed for any distributee.

8. None of the beneficiaries of this estate and no persons otherwise interested in this estate are now in the active service or on active duty in any of the United States Armed Forces and do not come within the provisions of the Soldiers' and Sailors' Civil Relief Act of 1940 and amendments thereto.

9. Decedent died seized of the following described real estate with improvements located in Madison County, Wisconsin:

The laws of the State of Wisconsin shall control the passage of title to this real estate.

10. All statutory requirements relating to taxes have been fully complied with and there are no income, estate, or inheritance taxes due from decedent's estate or from the Executor.

11. The Executor has made a diligent search for possible debts and claims against the estate, and the Executor has complied with all statutory requirements pertaining to claims. All debts and claims known to the Executor have been paid; no liens exist on any property as security for a claim or debt.

12. All expenses of Decedent's last illness and funeral and all other debts and charges of the estate have been paid or otherwise disposed of, including Executor fees previously allowed by this court, however the balance of the attorney fees in the amount of \$15,000 previously allowed by this court have not been paid. The Executor has been informed of its right to request an itemization of services performed, time spent for services, and responsibilities assumed by its attorney with respect to this estate and has elected not to request such itemization.

13. The assets of this estate have been distributed as provided for by the Last Will and Testament of the Decedent and by the laws of the State of Iowa, and receipt for the same has been executed by all interested parties and filed herein showing said distribution. Further accounting for distribution and for the handling of the affairs of this estate has been waived by the Distributees, said waiver, receipt for property due and consent to the approval of this report being on file herein.

14. The Executor has fully administered the affairs of the estate to the best of its abilities and in accordance with the provisions of law and all orders of this Court.

WHEREFORE, the Executor prays that an Order be entered herein approving this Final Report, confirming its acts as Executor of the estate, discharging the Executor of the estate from all further duties and responsibilities as such, and granting such other and further relief as this Court deems just and proper.
